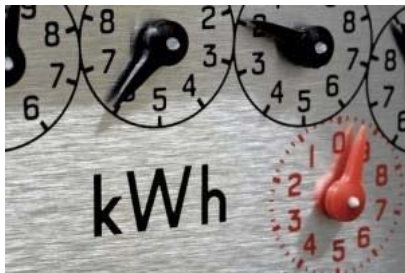

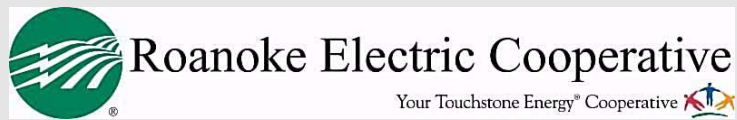
**Office closing: Memorial Day**
